- How to make use of the free text box found in the clinical preferencing section of the graduate portal application
- How to preference Metro South Health first
- How to indicate your preference of facilities within Metro South Health

Metro South Health will only appoint graduates through the graduate portal process. Step 1

The portal will ask you to nominate your clinical preferences from the 3 drop down box options of

- Rotational shifts across all areas of midwifery practice
- Midwifery Group Practice or continuity of midwifery care
- Work in one specific area of midwifery practice (e.g., Birth Suites)




The above step will need to be repeated for all clinical preferences so that your personal clinical preferences are ranked from 1 - 3

Metro South Health appreciates that not all clinical preferences, maybe offered in your Metro South Health facility of choice, however it is important that this reflects your personal clinical preferences as this information may be used by other HHS listed as part of your preferencing.

How to preference Metro South Health first?


Step 2

Metro South Health is a Group B HHS – This means you must provide a second preference. If your second preference is in Group A you are not required to provide any other preferences. If your second preference HHS is in Group B you must provide a minimum of 3 preferences, up to a maximum of 6.



Step 3

You are required to select your top 3 facility prefrences for your first Hospital and Health Service preference. You can not select a facility twice. Metro South Health appreciates that Maternity graduate programs are only on offer at two facilities in the Hospital and Health Service Logan Hospital and Redland Hospital however the portal requires you to enter 3 in order to proceed, Please enter Beaudesert Hospital as your 3rd preference to permit your application to proceed.

Graduate Nursing and Midwifery Portal opens on the 28th of June 2024 and closes on the 4th of August 2024.
