Service Overview

Community and Oral Health (COH) in Metro South Health (MSH) provide a range of population and patient centred strategies with the aim of supporting patients to be able to live independently in the community.

Redland Residential Care (RRC) Blue Gum & Red Gum Units

Blue Gum is a 32-bed complex frail aged unit which accommodates residents with complex chronic health conditions and bariatric residents.

Red Gum is a 32-bed unit accommodating 16 residential transition care (intermediary between acute and community) beds targeting restorative rehabilitation and 16 frail aged beds.

Daintree/Boronia is a combined unit which includes Daintree with 15 Psychogeriatric beds (a gazetted mental health extended treatment and rehab model). Boronia is a 16-bed step down behaviour unit for transitioning patients from the dementia and psychogeriatric unit back to the community or to another area of RRC or to other accommodation.

Acacia is a 31-bed secure dementia specific secure unit that houses complex mobile residents.
