- QEII is a medium-sized hospital with 205 beds with an additional 44 beds offsite and more than 1700 staff.
- Currently QEII is undergoing an expansion project to add another 112-bed specialised surgical facility by 2027 to assist with future growth and become the premier surgical hospital for Metro South Health.
- QEII provides a range of inpatient and outpatient services including general medicine, general surgical, cardiology, geriatric medicine, intensive care, acute stroke, palliative care, and has a state-of-the-art Emergency Department and Endoscopy Suite.

Unit Information

The QEII Intensive Care Unit (ICU) includes a 5-bed ICU and 2-bed High Dependency Unit (HDU). ICU provides specialised and contemporary intensive supportive care to critically unwell and complex patients, ensuring that we provide a service that meets the needs and expectations of our community. We are committed to delivering a highly skilled workforce that is dedicated to delivering high quality healthcare and is driven to meeting key clinical and quality performance indicators.

Our Activity

The ICU provides a 24-hour service, 365 days a year. It manages over 500 patient admissions per year, with various medical and post-operative surgical conditions including respiratory, urology, orthopaedic, renal, and gastrointestinal.

ICU Transition Program

The program is designed to improve the knowledge and skills of RNs transitioning into ICU. The program is equivalent to 300-hours of learning and consists of 4 modules and 4 assessments to complete over a 12-month period. The program builds skills, knowledge, and critical thinking along the continuum from novice to advanced beginner.

Key learning areas:

- Time Critical Specialty Modules
- Airway and Oxygenation
- Mechanical Ventilation
- Cardiac Electrophysiology
- Haemodynamic Monitoring
- Fluid dynamics/Renal
- Gastrointestinal / Endocrine
- Neurological Monitoring

TSP Education and Assessment

- The program is assessed both theoretically and clinically.
- The theoretical assessment consists of two case histories.
- The clinical assessment involves assessment of clinical competence at the bedside with 2 x 8hour CPAT assessments.
