#### Delirium management, and Dementia.

Delirium is a complex and acute neuropsychiatric syndrome characterised by disturbances in attention, cognition, and awareness. It is prevalent among hospitalised patients, especially the elderly and those with underlying medical conditions. The hallmarks feature's of delirium include rapid onset and fluctuating course, often exacerbated during evening hours (Sundowning). Patients may exhibit disorientation, perceptual disturbances, and changes in behaviour ranging from hypoactive (withdrawn and lethargic) to hyperactive (agitated and combative).

2M Nurses play a crucial role in early recognition and management, using validated screening tools like the 4AT to assess cognitive function and detect delirium promptly. Management strategies focus on identifying and addressing underlying causes, such as infections, medication side effects, or metabolic disturbances.

2M Nurses use non-pharmacological interventions, including environmental modifications, orientation techniques, and reassurance, which are all integral to maintaining a safe and low-stimulated environment conducive to recovery.

Collaboration with interdisciplinary teams ensures comprehensive care plans are tailored to each patient, emphasizing prevention, early intervention, and supportive care to mitigate the impact of delirium on patient outcomes.
