Addiction Services is a free, professional and confidential service for individuals, families, carers and communities impacted by substance use. Our service provides a specialist team approach.

The service deals with any kind of substance use including alcohol, tobacco, illicit drugs, prescription drugs, inhalants and over the counter preparations.

Who do we assist?

Anyone in the Metro South area having issues with alcohol, tobacco or other drugs. This includes people affected by the substance use of others.

No referral is needed - you can access our service in person or by phone, or you may be referred by a GP or other service.

Services

Services are provided within a harm minimisation framework and include:

- comprehensive assessment, counselling, psychological and social support
- opiate treatment program
- outpatient withdrawal services
- relapse prevention
- group programs
- client advocacy
- outreach
- education and promotion activities
- referral to a range of services

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander and Peer Support Workers are available in some locations.

The Preventative Team

The team works within the Metro South area providing community engagement and education, developing resources and raising awareness to prevent or minimise the harm associated with alcohol, tobacco and other drugs.

Queensland Drug and Alcohol Court (QDAC) service

Problem-oriented / solution-focussed courts with a focus on the relationship between treatment motivation and treatment outcomes. Referrals to the program are via magistrate courts and legal representatives.

Needle Syringe Program (NSP)

The NSP supplies sterile injecting equipment to people who inject drugs. The program reduces injecting drug use harm, without condoning such drug use. Addiction Services operates several NSPs across the Metro South area and there are 24-hour vending machines that dispense injecting equipment for a \$2 fee available. Please contact your local Addiction Services clinic for details of your nearest NSP and vending machine site.
