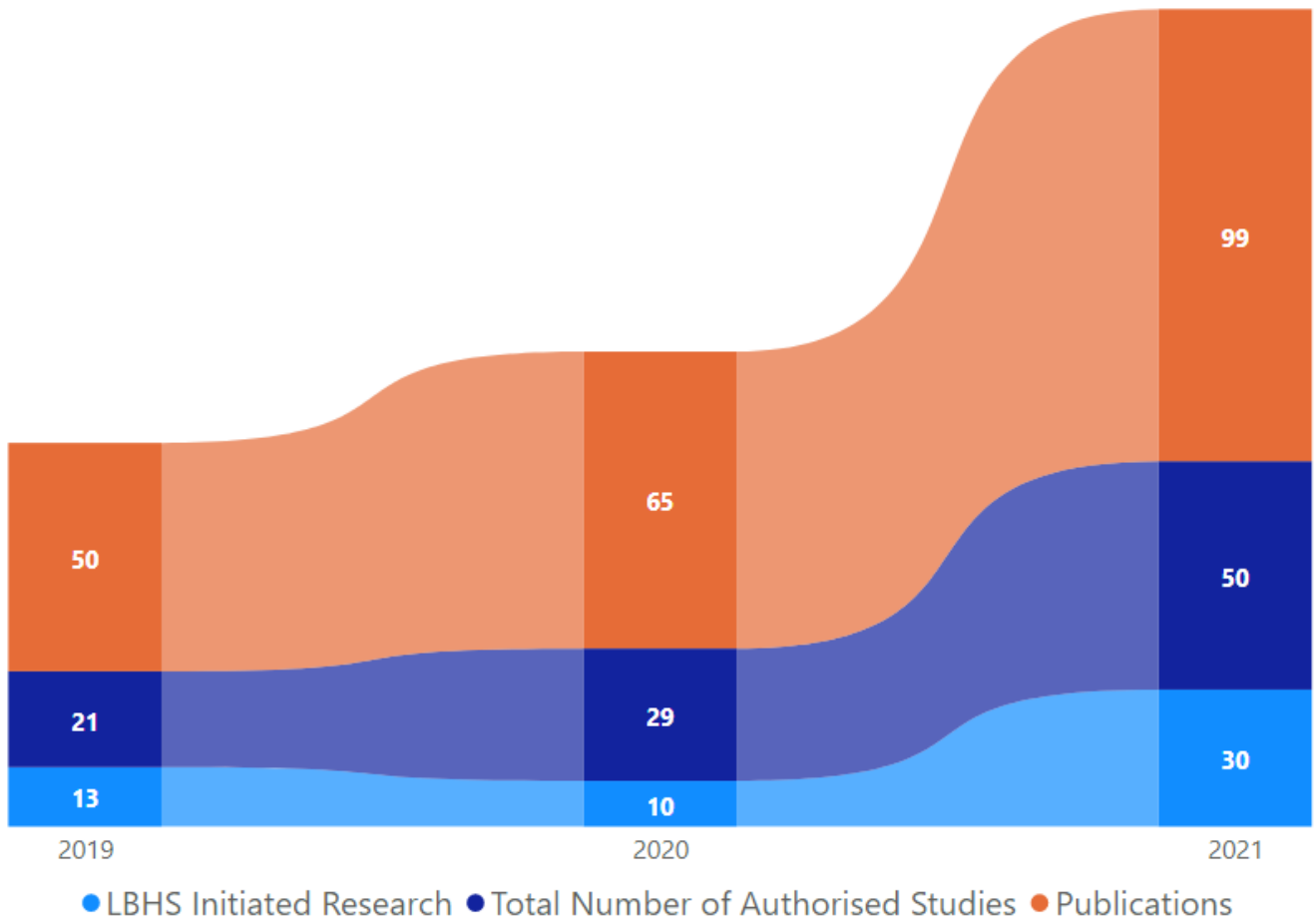

Three Year Snapshot in Research Growth across LBHS

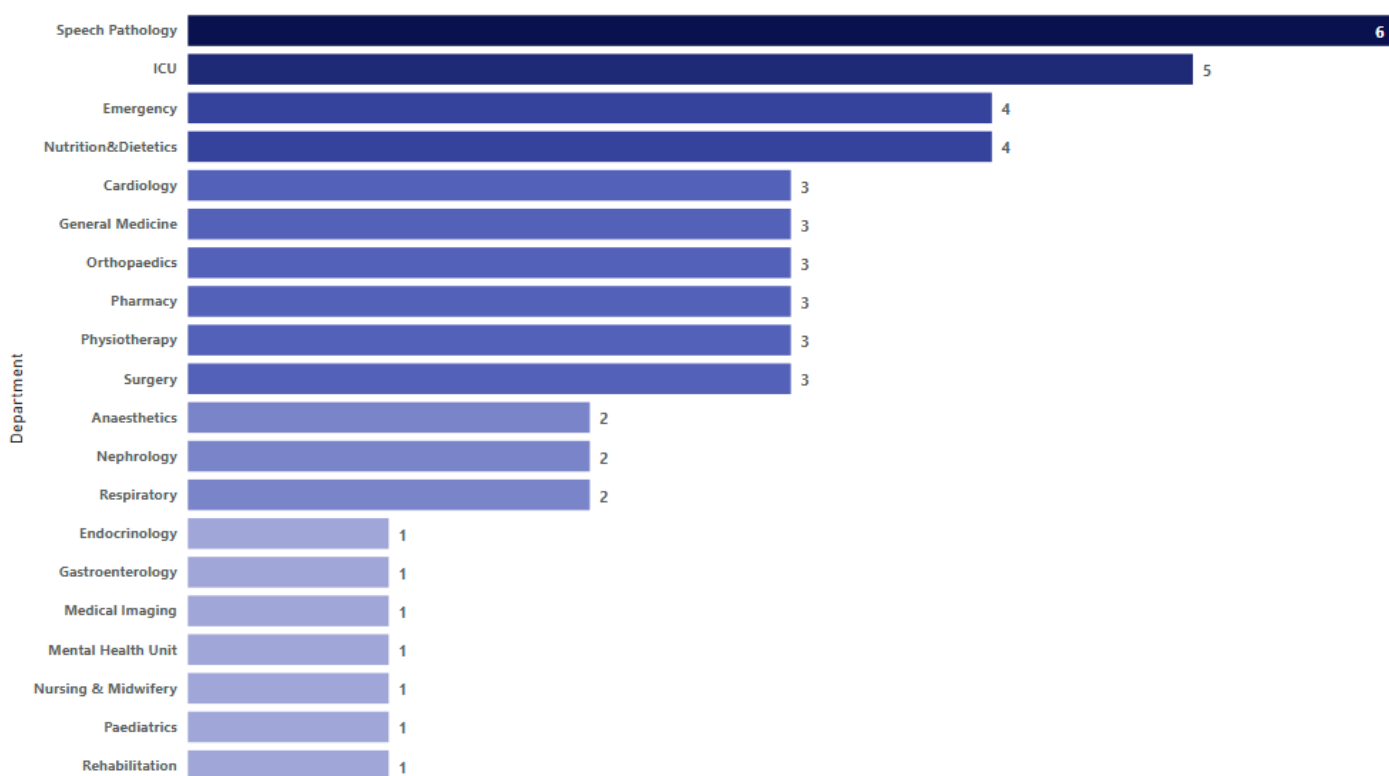

Growth in LBHS Research Activity by Year



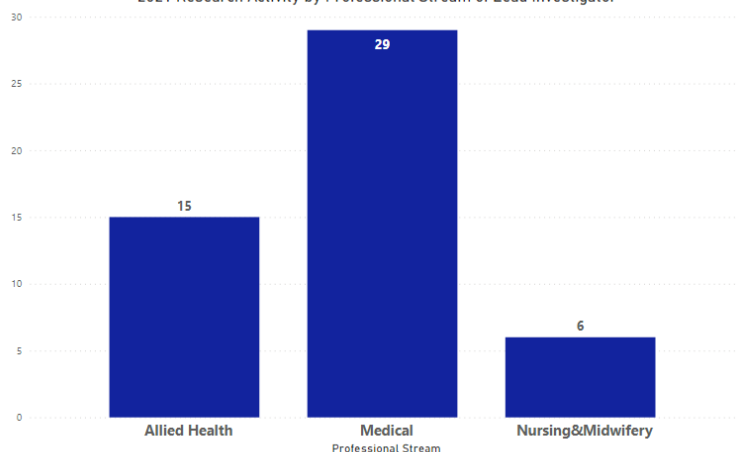
Breakdown of 2021 Research Activity

Number of New Research Authorisations by Department

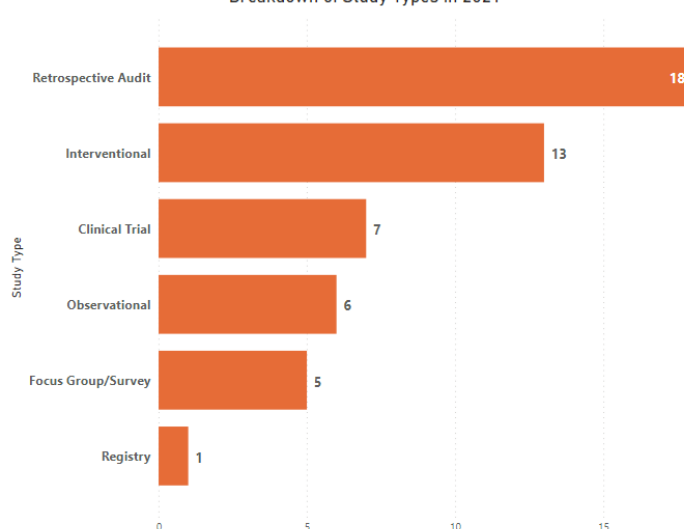

Evaluation of service and clinical outcomes from an innovative student-resourced physiotherapy clinic for patients with chronic musculoskeletal pain.

Linda Parnwell, Senior Physiotherapist within Logan Hospital, was successful in obtaining a grant from the Metro South Research Support Scheme in 2021. This study aims to evaluate an innovative student-resourced physiotherapy clinic for patients with chronic musculoskeletal conditions.

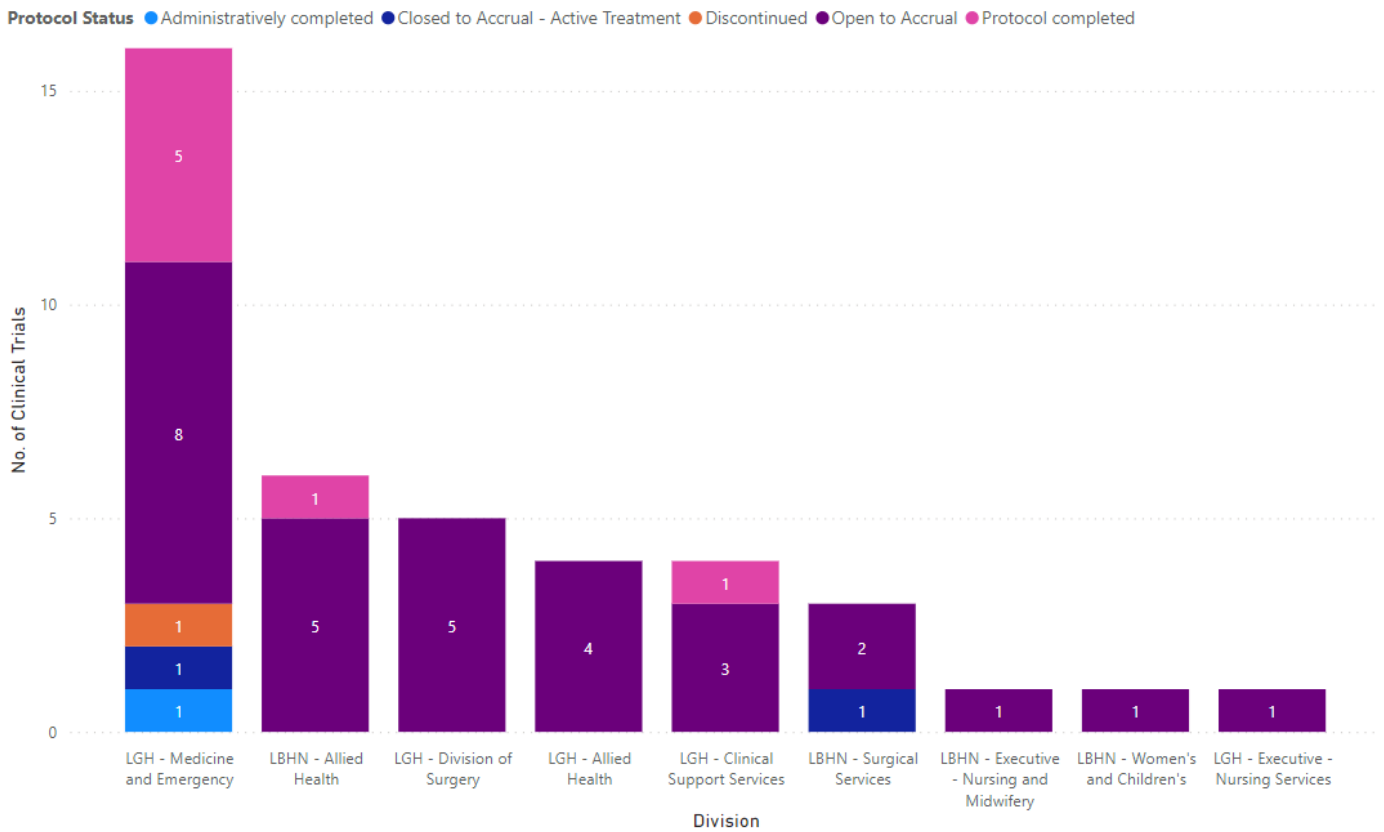
This research is the first to profile service activity and outcomes of a student-resourced musculoskeletal outpatient physiotherapy clinic managing patients with chronic musculoskeletal conditions. Additionally, this research will provide evidence of economic viability and aid in decision making regarding models of care and provision of funding and services for public health musculoskeletal outpatient physiotherapy services.

It is hoped this student-resourced clinic will demonstrate effective management of wait lists, efficient access to services, reduced pain scores and improved quality of life are anticipated outcomes for the clients of this study.

“It has been exciting to collaborate with Griffith Uni and establish a satellite service for LGH MSK Outpatient services. Anecdotally we have received consistently positive feedback from patients and staff. This research will allow us to quantitatively and qualitatively evaluate outcomes and provide data on what we believe is a quality service providing evidence informed and effective treatment for patients in our community.” - Linda

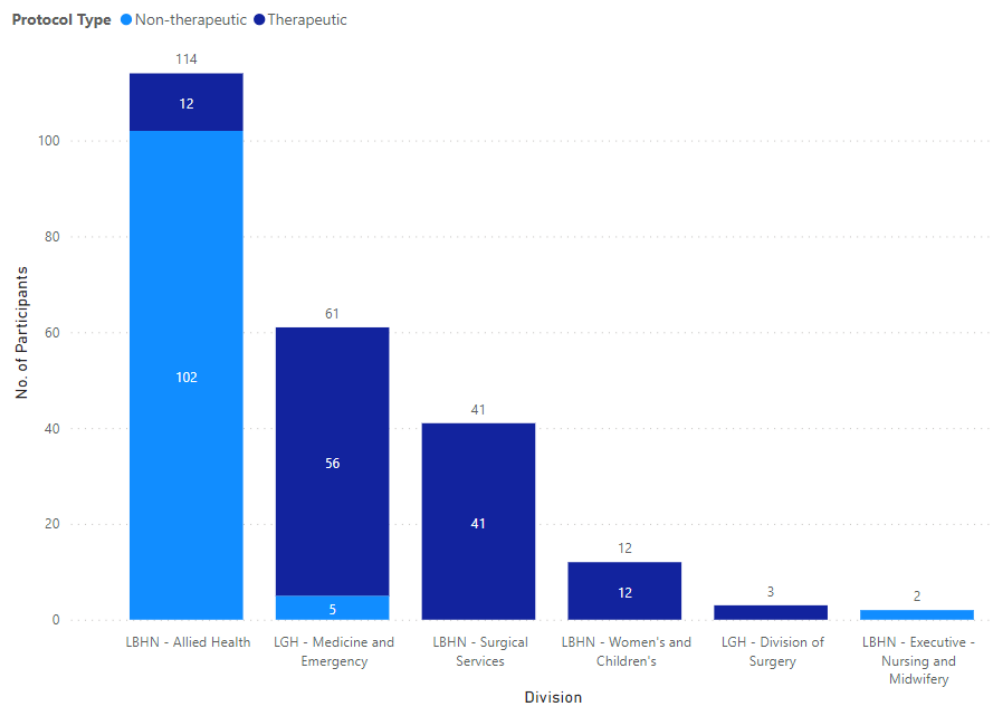

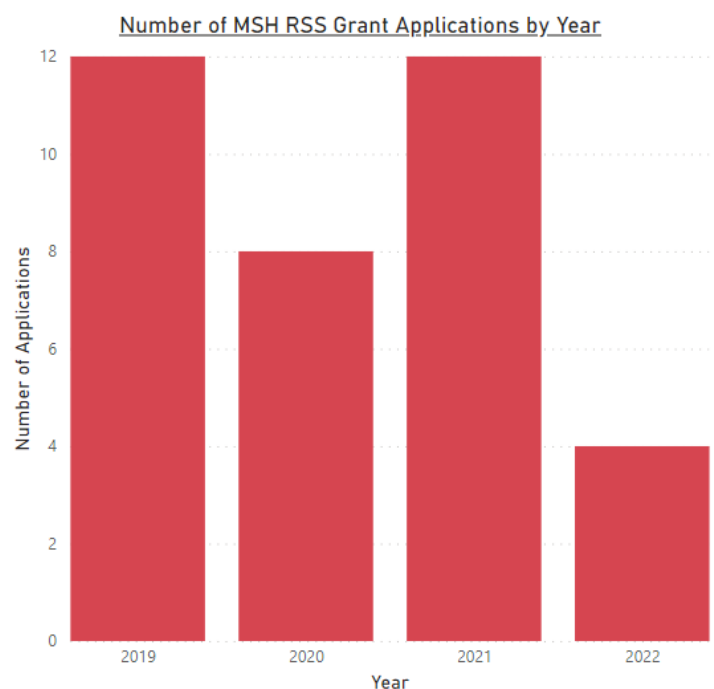

Community Maternity Hubs - Placed based community led action for collective impact

Logan Hospital's MGP MUM Michelle O'Connor is celebrating after being awarded a \$100,00 SERTA grant to continue to investigate maternity hub outcomes.

Michelle and partner, the Griffith University Midwifery Department, will investigate longer term outcomes including the social implication and the social return on investment not previously identified through earlier evaluations.

"Our hypothesis is that the Maternity Hub model improves short and long-term health and wellbeing for priority populations across the life trajectory," Michelle said.

"The project will apply mixed-methods employing a cultural safety lens, supported by the principles of the RISE framework and we expect the outcomes to include a detailed understanding of what access and engagement means to service users of the Logan Community Maternity and Child Health Hubs, including strategies to meet the needs of those who are currently under-served within the identified populations.

We also hope to develop a research framework driven by collective impact, co-design and cultural safety and build a body of research to ensure sustainability, expansion, replicability, and acceleration of scalability of the Community Maternity and Child Health Hub Model."
