Brisbane Metro South Sexual Health provides the following sexual health service:



Tests and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STI's) and other conditions affecting the anal & genital area



HIV testing and management including HIV post exposure prophylaxis (PEP)

What makes BMSSH different?

The clinical staff at BMSSH are highly skilled male and female doctors and nurses who are experienced in sexual health. This is a free and confidential service, Medicare card may be required. If you do not have a Medicare Card, or are not from a country with a Reciprocal Health Care Agreement with Australia, you will be billed for the costs of consultations, pathology tests and medication.

Clinics available

Sexual health clinics [PA Hospital](#) and [Logan Hospital](#) - 30 minute appointment for testing, examination and treatment.

Xpress clinics - 15 minute appointments for STIs and HIV screening for people, **over 18 years with no symptoms**. People with symptoms should make a regular appointment.

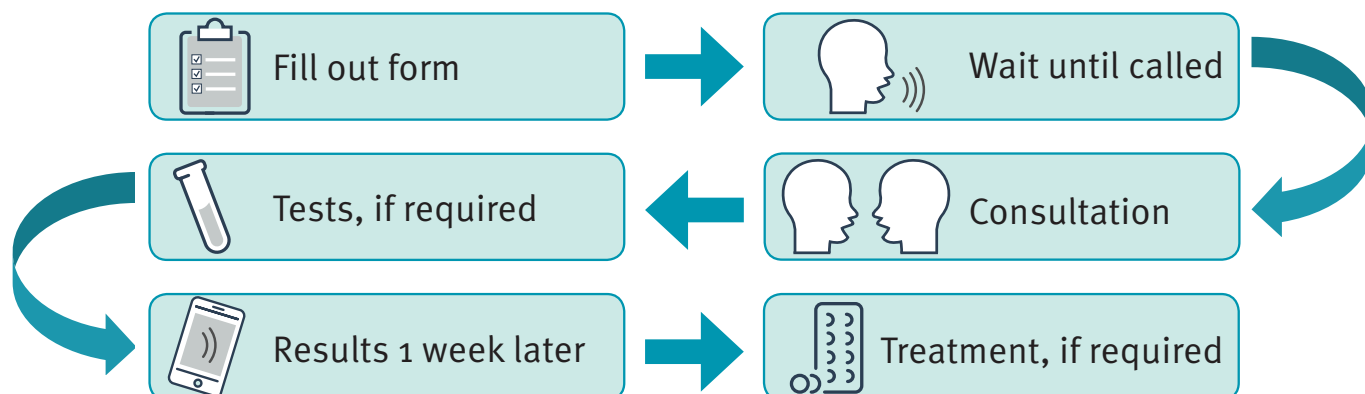
On the spot youth screening at various locations

Appointments

On arrival you will be asked to fill in a registration form with basic information including your name, date of birth, contact details and Medicare number. You will receive a card with your clinic number and our contact details.

The doctor or nurse will discuss your sexual health history and any current concerns you have plus the need for any tests or treatment. You may need to return for treatment or to get your results.
