Vascular nursing is a multi-dimensional specialty involving many complex conditions with multiple and extensive co-morbidities.

The Vascular Unit is an energetic 24-bed unit providing complex and specialised care to acutely ill vascular patients.

The unit accepts both elective and emergency admissions from Queensland and Northern New South Wales.

Nursing staff develop a wide range of clinical skills and gain vast experience in many areas including:

- Prostaglandin, Alteplase, Insulin and Heparin Infusions
- PCA, Epidurals and Niki pumps
- Wound drainage
- Indwelling catheters
- Naso-gastric tubes
- Extensive and specialised wound management, including VAC assisted and Zinc bandaging
- Pre and post-operative care
- Pain management
- PICC and CVL lines
- Doppler
- Stump bandaging

## Surgical procedures

- Carotid thromboendarterectomy
- Femoral popliteal bypass graft
- Femoral to femoral bypass graft
- Abdominal aortic aneurysm repair
- Abdominal bi-femoral bypass graft
- Axilla bi-femoral bypass graft
- Endoluminal abdominal aneurysm repair
- Thrombectomy of any artery or existing graft
- Lumbar chemical sympathectomy
- Varicose veins repair
- Thoroscopic sympathectomy
- First rib resection
- Above / below knee and transmetatarsal amputation
- Bilateral femoral angiogram
- Carotid / coronary / femoral angiogram
- Balloon angioplasty
- Insertion of arterial stent
- Insertion of venous / arterial catheter for titration of "alteplase"
